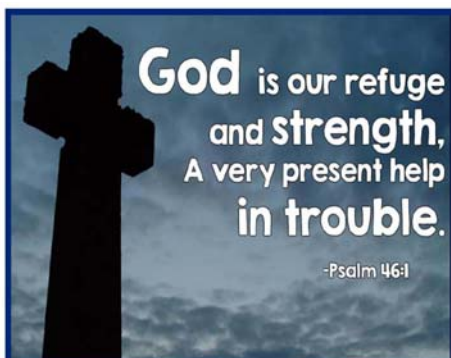

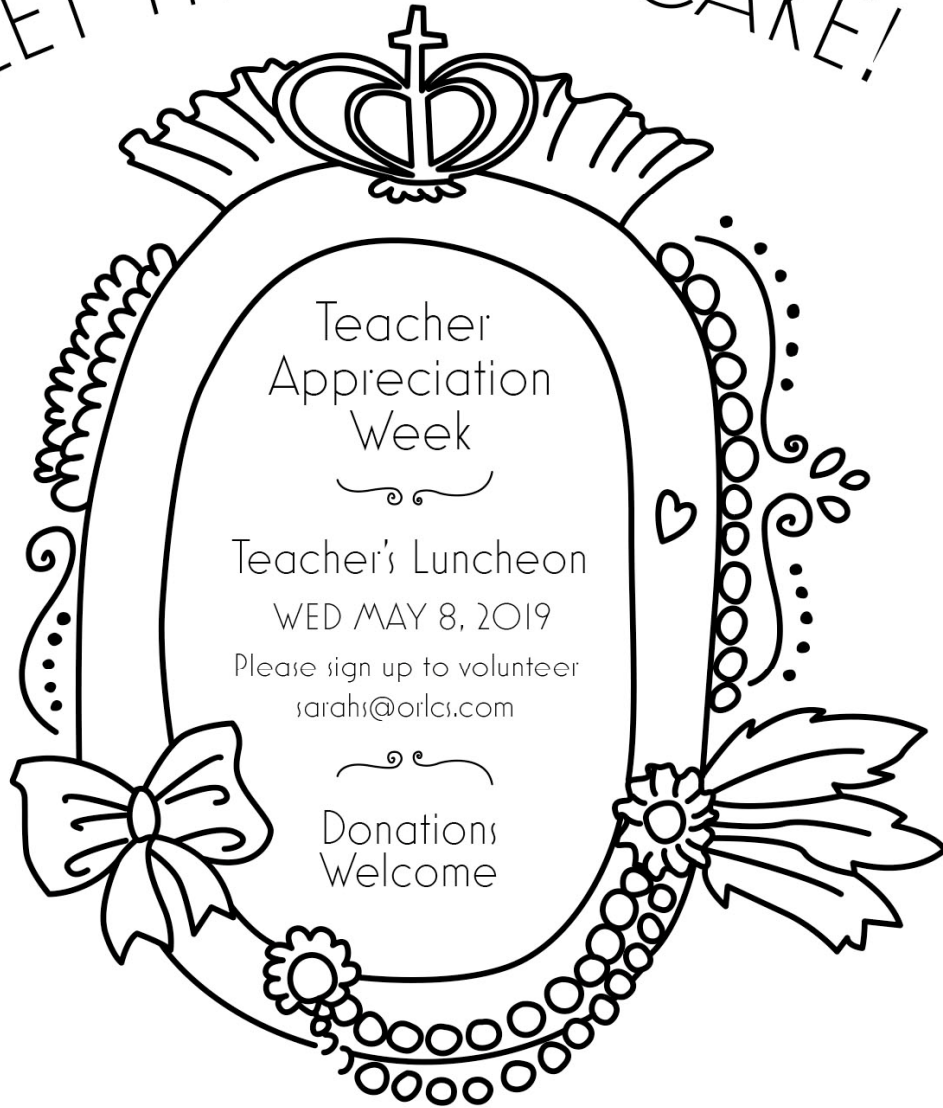


Musical and Retirement Celebration for Mrs. Tholen
